- 1898-1958
- First car had only 1 cylinder
- Produced the first six-cylinder engine in 1906
- Business plan was always to target the elite automobile purchaser
- Known for their attention to detail
- 1911 operated the largest automobile factory in the world
- First to sell through licensed dealers
- During WWII build more than 50,000 engines for the Army's P51 Mustang and the Navy's swift boat (PT) program
- Their advertising slogan was **"Ask the Man who OWNS ONE"**
