The Mack AC

- The Mack brothers, "Built, not Assembled" multitask vehicles
- 1893: First truck was (40hp) "Old #9," a 20passenger sightseeing vehicle in NYC
- Expanded to build most of the construction vehicles in the city
- 1910 built most of the fire trucks in America's large cities
- 1911, rolled out the MACK AC, 75hp, could carry 7 tons of bricks
- 1914, built 6,500 AC trucks to haul for the US Army. (English soldiers called them BULLDOGS) Thus the logo that still is used today on all Mack Trucks
- Made the first Semi-Trucks in the 1920s
- Semis haul 11.5 billion tons of freight each year

Built, not Assembled
