Psalm 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.

Colossians 1:16 For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.

I found this idea on the <u>Day One Journal App</u>. It's called a <u>Commonplace Book</u>. It's a collection of things that are part of your daily life on an intimate level. It's things that are <u>common</u> to you.



Here's how it works, using your phone:

1. Start collecting information that you find interesting, inspiring, or useful in your journal.

Pictures of your kids, scenery, things that make you go WOW.

2. As you read your bible this week; when a verse jumps out at you <u>take a picture of it</u>.

Or what did you hear in your worship music this week, in your favorite podcast, in a sermon, in an accompanying devotional book. Journal it and then take a pic of it.

- 3. Capture meaningful or thought-provoking quotes (or words that draw you closer in relationship to the Lord) from literature, social media, an online article, or interviews.

- 4. Collect something physical that connects you with God, i.e.: a flower, your father's pipe, a trophy, a teddy bear, or even a fish!

- 3. Finally write your own prayer to the Lord and lead us in prayer next week.
 - a. Let your prayer (be based on your 4 objects)
 - i. Acclaim He is Lord and worthy of worship
 - ii. Confess that we all need restoration
 - iii. Thank the Lord for his blessings, for restoring us, and drawing us to him
 - iv. Supplication: Give us our daily bread

Next week you will each bring in your object, pics and prayer.

- 1. Text us your pics, your inspirational quotes, your verses
- 2. Show us your object
- 3. Lead us in your prayer (this is your platform, run with it)
