



In 1916; Ernest Holmes (a mechanic), got a call from a friend. The friend had driven his Model T down a ravine in a mountainous part of Tennessee. In this moment the idea of the first Tow truck was born. Ernest took the back end off his 1913 Cadilac convertible and fitted it with outriggers and a PTO. By 1918 he held the patent. Commonly said Holmes' "Trucks Got The Job Done."
